Council of Ministers The Council of Ministers acts alone.	 E.g.: Article 31 TEU: decisions within the framework of the CFSP.
Commission The Commission acts alone.	 E.g.: Art. 106 (3) TFEU: undertakings with a special position; Arts. 290 and 291 TFEU: delegated powers.
Council of Ministers and Commission The Council and the Commission act together.	 E.g.: Art. 31 TFEU: Common Customs Tariff; Art. 242 TFEU: rules governing the committees provided for in the Treaties.
Commission, social partners, Council of Ministers, social partners procedure EU implementation of Framework Agreements of the European social partners.	E.g.: Arts. 154 and 155 TFEU: social law.
