## **ORDINARY LEGISLATIVE PROCEDURE (TFEU 294)**

The Commission's proposal to the European Parliament and the Council of the EU.

- **■** First reading
- --- The European Parliament adopts its position and communicates it to the Council;
- --- The Council of the EU:
  - ----approves the position the act shall be adopted;
  - ----does not approve the position adopts its position at I reading and communicates it to the European Parliament for II reading.
    - **■** Second reading
      - --- IF THE EUROPEAN PARLAMENT within 3 months:
    - ---- **Has not taken a decision** the act concerned shall be deemed to have been adopted in the wording which corresponds to the position of the Council;
    - ---- **Approves the Council's position** the act concerned shall be deemed to have been adopted in the wording which corresponds to the position of the Council;
    - ---- Rejects the Council's position the proposed act shall be deemed not to have been adopted; or
    - ----**Proposes amendments to the Council's position** the text thus amended shall be forwarded to the Council and to the Commission, which shall deliver an opinion on those amendments.
      - --- IF THE COUNCIL OF THE EU
    - ---- Approves all those amendments acting by a qualified majority the act shall be deemed to have been adopted;
    - ---- **Does not approve the amendments** a meeting of the Conciliation Committee shall be convened.
      - Third reading
        - --- If the Conciliation Committee approves a joint text the act is adopted if approved by:
          - ---- The Council (by a qualified majority); and
          - ---- **The Parliament** (by a majority of the votes cast);
        - --- If the Conciliation Committee fails to approve the text the act shall be deemed not to have been adopted.
