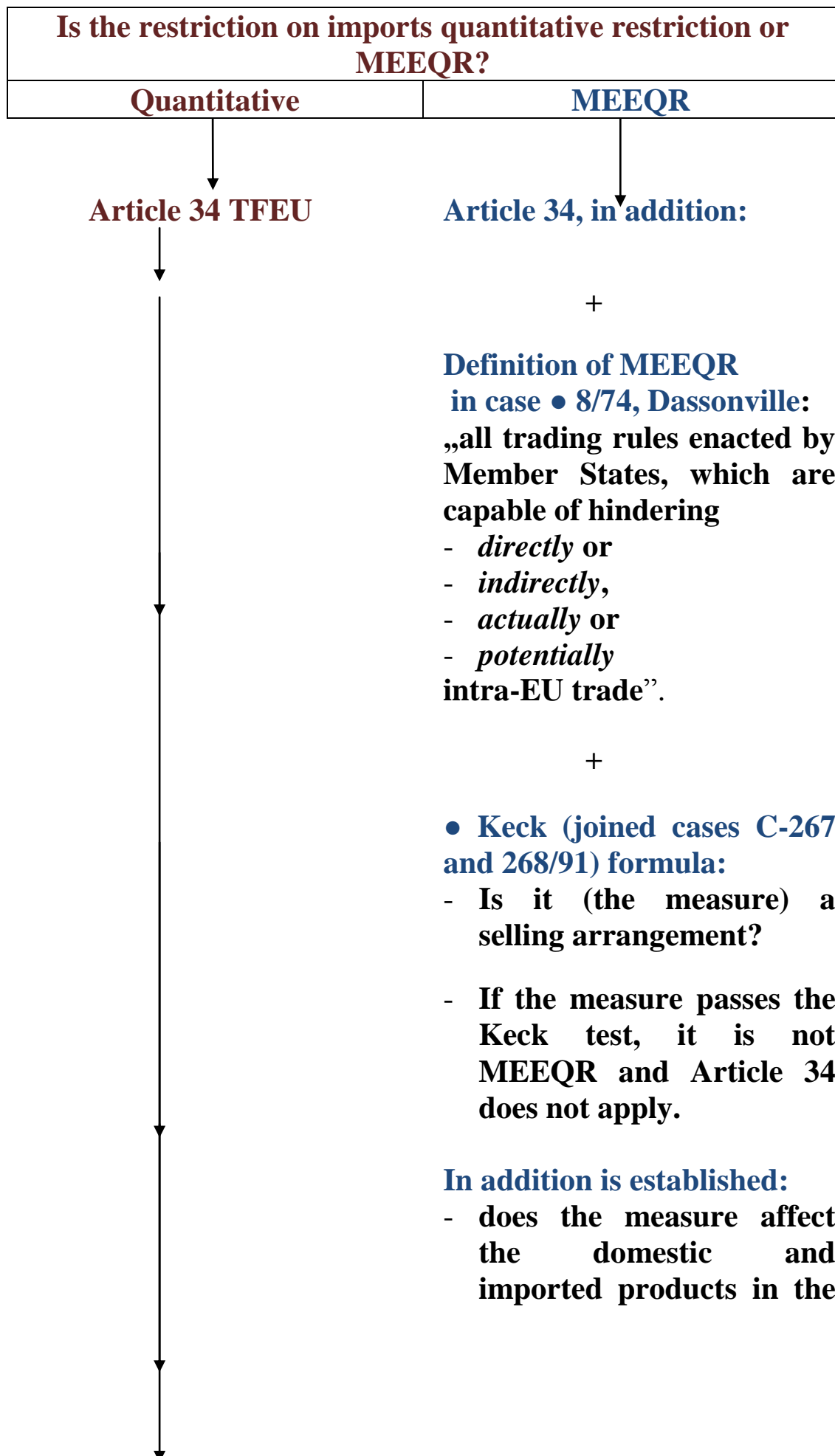

The flowchart is structured as follows:
